Chapter 5 is a non-profit, residential environment dedicated to providing men with the tools, structure, and support needed in their successful recovery from alcoholism and drug addiction. We offer a clean, safe and sober setting based on the spiritual principles of Alcoholics Anonymous and other 12-step programs.

We welcome all adult males who are alcoholics/addicts, including the homeless and/or unemployed, regardless of age, race, creed or religion, sexual preference, or ethnic origin.

A desire to not drink or use drugs and a willingness to commit to our 25 week program, and a commitment to becoming self supporting as an investment in the individual's recovery are the only requirements for consideration for resident status.

In the long term, we want Chapter 5 to be a continuing positive influence in our Guest's lives of recovery and encourage them to remain close and in contact with the house and its new residents.

At Chapter 5

We offer an effective program where alcoholics/addicts will gain lasting results from a long-term commitment to sobriety. Our structured family environment of men committed to supporting each other in recovery from alcoholism and drug addiction is combined with a 12-step program requiring daily participation. Our goal is to help those who are serious about their recovery, and we have a large number of alumni who have remained clean and sober for over a year.

At Chapter 5 feelings are valued, shared freely, and explored fully without fear of physical, verbal or emotional confrontation. We support success in all areas of our lives, combined with a healthy acceptance of failure. Our group goal is constant improvement in the spiritual, emotional and physical growth of Chapter 5 Guests. We upgrade. We progress. We live by a higher standard.

Although Chapter 5 is open to all who desire to stop drinking and/or using drugs, residency is limited to those who are willing and able to accept and practice the following Rules and Standards. All new residents of Chapter 5 must be accepted by a majority vote of the current residents after a thirty (30) day probationary period that demonstrates their understanding and commitment to....

A minimum stay of 25 weeks is required.

Our Program

1. Follow through on all treatment commitments.
2. Daily attendance at an early morning community 12-step program meeting (work schedule permitting)
3. Daily attendance at a noon community 12-step program meeting (work schedule permitting).
4. Daily attendance at a mainstream evening community 12-step program meeting (no exceptions without prior permission)
5. Daily attendance at the Chapter 5 house meeting (no exceptions without prior permission).
6. Daily contact with a program sponsor to share experiences and receive guidance and direction to work the Steps and rebuild your life.
7. Acquire and maintain a fellowship commitment, i.e.; making coffee, secretary, treasurer, greeter, clean-up, etc.
8. Daily reading of program literature, primarily the "Big Book" of Alcoholics Anonymous.
9. Under the supervision of a qualified sponsor, work the 12 steps of Alcoholics Anonymous.
10. Practice total abstinence from all mind-altering drugs, chemicals and alcohol.
11. Maintain strict adherence to all Chapter 5 Rules and Standards, and duties.

Our Fees

The Chapter 5 program runs for 25 weeks.

The fees at Chapter 5 are:

- One week deposit, refundable after successful completion of the program, paid in advance.
- Fees are paid weekly in advance. Please visit our website or call us for current rates.

Outside counseling, medical supervision, therapy and other health treatment, as appropriate, is available at the residents own expense.

Guests are responsible for buying and preparing their own food, and for all transportation needs. Chapter 5 provides basic house cleaning supplies and paper products.

OUR LOCATIONS

Chapter 5 has three locations in beautiful and historic North Central Arizona:

Prescott is ideally situated in the Bradshaw Mountains about 2 hours from Phoenix. This mile high community is located amid tall pines and boasts spectacular views. It has the best of both worlds—the dry, warm climate of the desert and the cool lofty atmosphere of the mountains.

Cottonwood lies at the heart of the Verde Valley northeast of Prescott. A charming and relaxed atmosphere pervades this area, which is home to a scenic railway and is the gateway to the breathtaking Red Rocks of Sedona.
